In re: Electronic Transmission of Court Mandates to Registered eDCA Users


BY ORDER OF THE COURT:

Effective June 25, 2012, all mandates issued by this court will be transmitted to registered eDCA users in electronic format only. Mandates will be transmitted to eDCA users through a link provided via Casemail. Paper versions of the court's mandates will no longer be sent to registered users, including lower tribunals, clerks, and lower tribunal judges.

This court's Administrative Order 12-1, issued February 15, 2012, provided for the electronic transmission of all orders of this court to registered eDCA users in electronic format only effective March 1, 2012. Administrative Order 12-2, issued May 3, 2012, provided for the electronic transmission of all opinions of this court to registered eDCA users in electronic format only effective May 7, 2012.

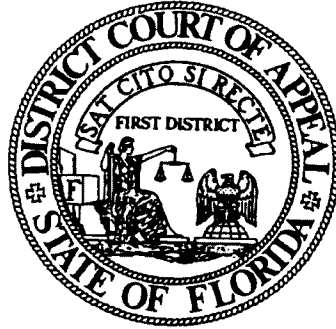
Beginning May 25, 2012, this court began issuing all new case acknowledgment letters electronically through eDCA to registered users.

Registered users are responsible for ensuring they have their correct email addresses updated with eDCA. Those who are not required to use eDCA will continue to receive mandates of the court in paper format.
