STIPULATED MOTION TO REDACT CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT

Respondent Gulf Coast Medical Center moves to redact a confidential document from the DOAH docket and file of this proceeding, and states in support as follows:

1. On June 6, 2008, the Petitioner filed a Voluntary Notice of Withdrawal of Claim and Dismissal with Prejudice of this Proceeding.
2. Following the filing of the Notice of Withdrawal of Claim, the Administrative Law Judge, on June 13, 2008, entered an Order Closing File, which canceled the hearing set for July 9 and closed the file in this matter.
3. However, before the Order Closing File could be entered, the Petitioner, who is *pro se*, *mistakenly* sent to the Clerk of DOAH a confidential document that was not intended by the parties to be filed; and the Clerk filed the confidential document on June 11, 2008 under the docket heading "Confidential Settlement Communication."
4. It is apparent on the face of the document that the parties intended the document to be kept confidential, and they did not intend for the document to be filed. The filing of the document was a mistake.
5. Both the Petitioner and the Respondent desire that this confidential document be

redacted from the DOAH docket and file of this Proceeding inasmuch as the parties never intended for the document to be filed, and the document is confidential. Moreover, the Petitioner has withdrawn her claim, and the file has been closed.


6. Where a litigant mistakenly makes an inadvertent disclosure of a confidential or privileged document as part of a filing with a Clerk of Court, the document does not lose its confidential character; and the Court may order that the confidential document be redacted or removed from the Court file. See, e.g., *Wilson v. Comfort Systems*, 2006 WL 1128703 (D. Kan. 2006); *Astaldi Const. Corp. v. M. Held Plumbing Co., Inc.*, 710 So.2d 225, 226 (Fla. 3rd DCA 1998).

WHEREFORE, Respondent (with Petitioner's Stipulation) requests that the Clerk of DOAH be directed to redact the confidential document from the DOAH docket and file of this proceeding and return the document to Petitioner or otherwise dispose of the document.



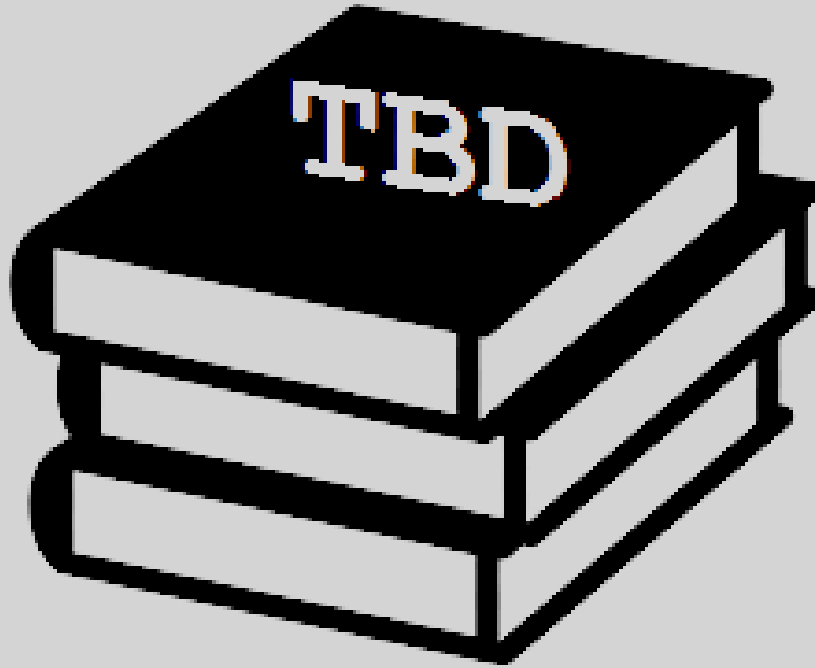
