Perpetrator: The Florida Commission on Human Relations (FCHR)

THE FCHR HELD AN ILLEGAL MEETING; VIOLATING STATE LAW (§286 FS)

The FCHR broke state law on September 21, 2023.

The agency did so by holding a **secret meeting** (in contravention of [§286 FS](#); also see [28-109.004\(2\) FAC](#)).^{1/}

Statement of the Facts

1. On September 13, 2023, the FCHR notified the public that it would be having a case disposition meeting.
2. The meeting was to be held on Thursday, September 21, 2023 (at 10:00 AM EST).
3. Importantly, the meeting was to be held with the use of [communications media technology](#).
4. On September 21, 2023, the FCHR held that meeting (at its prescribed time).
5. The public, however, was barred from attending it.

- a. Reason = the FCHR's *communications media technology* prevented participants from joining the meeting.
 - b. According to FCHR staff, the prevention was due to a technical difficulty.
 - c. The Undersigned (ie, a member of the public) hereby attests that he was blocked from attending the meeting.
6. Crucially, the FCHR immediately knew of the public's exclusion.
- a. At roughly 10:30 AM EST (9/1/23), FCHR staff relayed this acknowledgment to the Undersigned (after-the-fact).
7. In fact, during the meeting, FCHR staff sent private communications to a select group of individuals; permitting only them to attend the meeting.
- a. Thereby conducting a '*secret meeting*'; secluded from the public.
8. After the meeting concluded, the FCHR told the Undersigned (via phone) that the FCHR would not nullify its secret meeting. Furthermore, the FCHR told the Undersigned that the FCHR would not reconvene its meeting.

Mitigating Harm, Preventing Legal Intervention

9. Upon collecting these facts, the Undersigned asked the FCHR to:
- a. rescind any/all official decisions that the FCHR rendered during its secret meeting; and
 - b. reconvene its meeting; by permitting the public to fully attend.
10. Given the FCHR's recidivism^{1/}, the Undersigned gave the FCHR a deadline of 3PM EST on September 21, 2023 (to obey the law).
11. The state agency, however, failed to meet that deadline.

Legal Application

Pursuant to [§286.011\(1\) FS](#), the actions that the FCHR took during That Meeting are null & void.

According to that same statute, the State of Florida is **authorized to imprison/fine the FCHR** (via [§286.011\(3\) FS](#)).

When confronted with this reality, the state agency neither:

(a) disputed the facts; nor

(b) agreed to nullify/rectify its unlawful conduct.

Conduct, notably, that the Undersigned has brought to the FCHR's attention on several prior occasions.

In short, the FCHR knowingly violated the public's right (statutory - [§286.011 FS](#); and constitutional - [1st Amendment](#)) to attend a public meeting.

Request

So, may you please:

- (a) gather the necessary evidence;
- (b) charge the FCHR with violating [§286](#);
- (c) punish the FCHR (in accordance with the law); and
- (d) enjoin the FCHR from violating [§286](#) ever again.

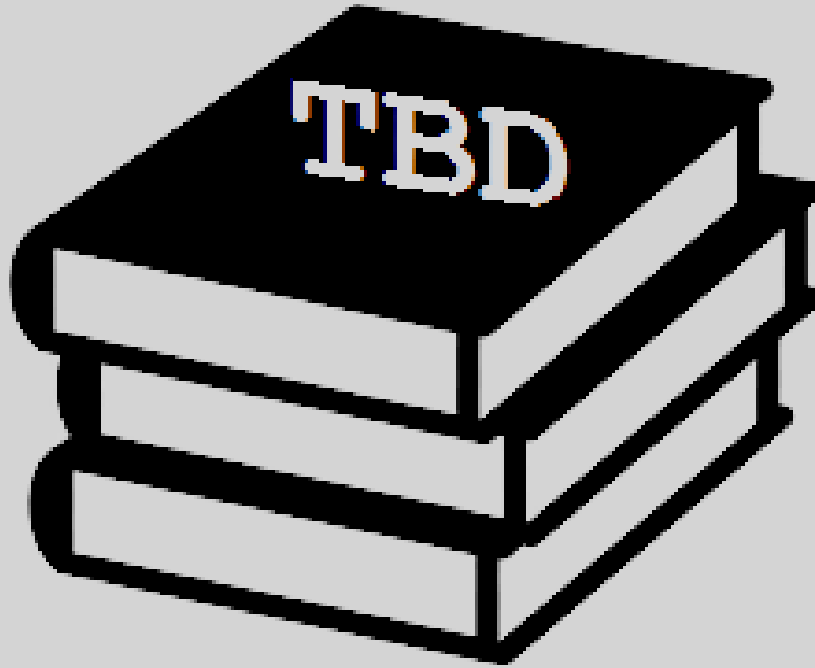
