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**RELATOR'S MOTION FOR ACCESS TO THE DOCKET**

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Relator, ELIAS MAKERE, on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 2022, hereby moves this Court - pursuant to Rule 1.010 Fla. R. Civ. P. - to grant all parties access to the progress docket of this case.<sup>1/</sup> Relator proffers the following in good faith, and only on the grounds permitted by Rule 2.420 Fla. R. Jud. Admin.

Key Points:

B.) Grounds constitutional

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*In his public place, the defendant secreted evidence. In its private space, the klan secreted the defendant's secrets.*

*Now, in the secret place, the Court hides them all; secreting - even - from basic tenets of law.*

*So, given the non-adjudicable place this Court has placed the parties in, may it replace its sin, and grant access to all herein.*

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**Background:** Parties need to litigate this case  
**Problem:** The Court has prevented parties from accessing the docket  
**Request:** The Court grants parties full access in accordance with law

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**Art. I §24 FL Constitution | Access to Public Records... (highlights added)**

*"(a) Every person has the right to inspect or copy any public record made or received in connection with the official business of any public body, officer, or employee of the state, or persons acting on their behalf, except with respect to records exempted pursuant to this section or specifically made confidential by this Constitution."*

**Rule 2.420(j) (2) | Procedure for Obtaining Access... (highlights added)**

*"A court order allowing access to confidential court records may be obtained by filing a written motion which must:*

*(A) identify the particular court record(s)... with as much specificity as possible...;*

*(B) specify the bases for obtaining access to such court records;*

*(C) set forth the specific legal authority for obtaining access to such court records; and*

*(D) contain a certification that the motion is made in good faith and is supported by a sound factual and legal basis."*

**Rule 2.420(m) | Procedure...Access to Judicial... (highlights added)**

*"(1) Requests for access to judicial branch records shall be in writing and shall be directed to the custodian. The request shall provide sufficient specificity to enable the custodian to identify the requested records. The reason for the request is not required to be disclosed."*

**AOSC 22-7 | Access to Electronic Court Records**

*"Access levels are defined as follows:*

*B. All but expunged, or sealed under Ch. 943, F.S., or sealed by court order."*

**MOTION****I. Pertinent History**

1. On-or-around July 30, 2021, Relator filed this action on behalf of Plaintiff.
2. Soon thereafter, Relator forwarded the complaint to (a) Plaintiff; (b) Florida's Office of the Attorney General; and (c) Florida's Department of Financial Services. Doing so pursuant to §68.083(3) FS.
3. Approximately one year later (7/26/22), this Court ordered Relator/Plaintiff to obtain service of process.
4. Relator obliged, thereby requesting issuance of a summons; doing so on July 29, 2022. In the days that followed, however, Plaintiff learned that he could not receive the stamped summons.
  - a) Reason: this case (ie, 37-2021-CA-001360-XXXX-MA; Leon County; Florida) has been sealed.
5. Indeed, on that same day (Fri. July 29, 2022), the Honorable Clerk of Leon County told Relator that Relator would need to file a motion with the Court. The motion would be to request access to this case's docket. The Clerk also directed Relator to Supreme Court Administrative Order 22-7 (*Access to Electronic Records*).
6. On Monday, August 15, 2022, the Clerk apprised Relator to the fact that all case-specific orders would have been emailed to the parties. Thus, by deduction, there are no other orders on the docket (besides the aforementioned; ¶3 *supra*).

## II. Analysis

7. Relator does not have any access to the docket of this case (Exhibit A). Presumably, neither does Plaintiff; nor Defendant.
8. Without access to the docket, Relator cannot litigate this cause of action. Presumably, neither can Plaintiff; nor Defendant.
9. Relator cannot obtain a summons. Therefore, he cannot satisfy this Court's order (§3 *supra*).
10. This Court has never entered an order to seal any portions of this case (Exhibit B).

## III. Arguments in Favor of Judicial Notice

11. The parties have a **constitutional right** to the progress docket of this case (highlights added):

*"(a) Every person has the right to inspect or copy any public record made or received in connection with the official business of any public body, officer, or employee of the state, or persons acting on their behalf"*

- Art. I §24 FL Constitution

12. Plus, the parties have a **mandated right** to the progress docket. Pursuant to Administrative Order 22-7, each entity has "Level B" clearance on the case. "Level B" clearance, of course, means full access to case dockets (except for expunged and/or §943 sealed material):

*"Access levels are defined as follows:*

*B. All but expunged, or sealed under Ch. 943, F.S., or sealed by court order."*

- AOSC 22-7, FL Supreme Court

13. Third, the parties have a **practical need** for case docket access. In Relator's case, he cannot even summon Defendant without access to the docket (§9 *supra*).

#### IV. Standard of Review

14. According to Rule 2.420(m) Fla. R. Jud. Admin. (also see Rule 2.420(j)(2) for persuasive authority<sup>2/</sup>), Relator must hereby ask the custodian of this Court for the records that Relator needs (highlights added):

*"(1) Requests for access to judicial branch records shall be in writing and shall be directed to the custodian. The request shall provide sufficient specificity to enable the custodian to identify the requested records. The reason for the request is not required to be disclosed."*

- Rule 2.420(m) Fla. R. Jud. Admin.

15. In short, this Motion must be:

- a) in writing;
- b) directed to the custodian; and
- c) sufficiently specific about what records Relator needs.

16. Relator satisfies these elements as follows.

##### Element A) Written Form

17. As can be observed, this motion is in writing. Therefore, Relator has satisfied the first prong in this three-pronged analysis.

Element B) Directed to the Custodian

18. Pursuant to AOSC 19-74, the Chief Judge of each Florida circuit court is deemed the custodian of records:

*"Chief judges of the trial courts are responsible for overseeing implementation of judicial e-filing within their respective circuit, pursuant to the policies and guidance set forth in this administrative order."*

- Administrative Order 19-74, Florida Supreme Court

19. The Chief Judge of Leon County is the Honorable Jonathan Sjostrom.

20. Thus, Relator hereby asks Judge Sjostrom (as well as [presiding] Circuit Judge Cooper - if thereby deputized) to grant the parties access to the court docket.

21. With that formality complete, Relator has hereby satisfied the second prong in the three-prong standard of review.

Element C) Specify Records

22. Lastly, Relator is seeking access to the entire progress docket (all dates, all documents). He seeks it for himself; for Plaintiff; and for Defendant. Whereby Relator will be able to satisfy all court orders, litigate this case, and obtain a full & fair opportunity at justice:

*"thus serves simultaneously to meet the plaintiff's prima facie case by presenting a legitimate reason for the action and to frame the factual issue with sufficient clarity so that the plaintiff will have a full and fair opportunity to demonstrate pretext."*

- Texas DCA v. Burdine, 450 US 248 (1981)

23. Moreover, pursuant to the Access Security Matrix (**Exhibit C**) (AOSC 22-7), parties must be given access to the entire docket<sup>3/</sup>.

**CONFERRAL**

Given Defendant's preempted appearance in this action (ie, Defendant has yet-to-be served), Relator cannot report what Defendant's stance is on this motion.

Nevertheless, he believes the foregoing presents a compelling (ie, *constitutional*) and important (ie, *litigate case*) reason for obtaining the requested relief.

**CONCLUSION**

WHEREFORE, Relator respectfully asks this Court to grant full access to the case docket of this case (37-2021-CA-001360-XXXX-MA; Leon County; Florida).
