PETITION FOR WRIT OF QUO WARRANTO

Pursuant to Rule 9.100 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, Petitioner William Newkirk respectfully petitions the Court for a writ of quo warranto directed to the Respondent, State Attorney Robert Carney of the 17th Judicial Circuit State Attorney's Office, and shows the Court as follows:

I. BASIS FOR INVOKING JURISDICTION

This Court has jurisdiction to issue a writ of quo warranto under Article V, Section 3(b)(8) of the Florida Constitution, and Rule 9.030(a)(3) of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. *Martinez v. Martinez*, 545 So.2d 1338 (Fla. 1989); *State ex rel. Christian v. Austin*, 302 So.2d 811 (Fla. 1st DCA 1974).

Although the district courts of appeal and circuit courts also have a general constitutional power to issue writs of quo warranto, the petition in this case was properly filed in the Supreme Court. Article V, Section 3(b)(8) Florida Constitution provides that the Supreme Court shall have jurisdiction to issue writs of quo warranto to state officers and state agencies, and the Respondent in this case, a duly appointed state officer under the provisions of Article V, Section 17 of the Florida Constitution. For that reason, jurisdiction to issue a writ of quo warranto lies in the Supreme Court.

II. STATEMENT OF THE FACTS

1. The Petitioner was charged by indictment on November 20, 1980 for Count I – first degree murder (principle) contrary to Fla. Stat. 782.04 and 777.011; and on Count II – robbery with a deadly weapon (principle) contrary to Fla. Stat. 812.13(1)(2)(a) and 777.011. (Case No. 80-9947-CF-B).
2. Also on November 20th, 1980, the State Attorney Robert Carney filed an information. The charge of first degree murder contrary to Fla. Stat. 782.04 (Case No.: 80-10660-CF10A) was transferred into the indictment.

3. On February 12, 1981, the State Prosecutor, Robert Carney, *sua sponte*, informed a second armed robbery charge to the existing indictment and this charge was assigned Case No. 81-634-CF-B.

III. THE NATURE OF THE RELIEF SOUGHT

The nature of the relief sought by this petition is a writ of quo warranto directing the Respondent to demonstrate his authority to charge the Petitioner with felony murder on information contrary to the Florida Constitution.

IV. ARGUMENT

The authority of a state prosecutor is well defined in the Florida Statutes and it is well settled in the Florida Constitution, Art. I, § 15(a), that a grand jury indictment is required for valid commencement of proceedings for the "capital crime" of first degree murder. *Lowe v. Stack*, 326 So.2d 1 (Fla. 1974); *State ex rel. Manucy v. Wadsworth*, 293 So.2d 345 (Fla. 1974). By adding the charge of armed robbery by an information and "transferring" another murder charge, (Case No. 80-010660-CF10A), to the existing grand jury indictment (*See attachments*), the State Prosecutor, Robert Carney, overstepped his authority and personally charged the Petitioner with a new felony murder contrary to Florida Constitution Art I, § 15(a), which prohibits any person from being tried for a capital crime without presentment or indictment by a grand jury.

V. CONCLUSION

For this reason, the Petitioner respectfully submits that the Court should issue a writ of quo warranto. Furthermore, Petitioner prays that this case will be considered “the type of case in which an opinion from the court would provide important guiding principles for other courts of Florida”. *Rosalie Whiley v. Hon. Rick Scott, etc*, 79 So.3d 702, (Fla. 2011).
