FINAL ORDER DISMISSING REQUEST FOR
RELIEF FROM AN UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICE

Petitioner filed a complaint of discrimination claiming she was discriminated against because she was subjected to a hostile work environment condoned by Respondent, because of race and sex. There was no transcript and no exceptions found in the file. The Judge found for the Respondent on the merits because there was no evidence of discrimination, and recommended dismissal of the Petition.

The Judge's dismissal on the merits was correct since it was supported by competent substantial evidence in the record, and the Petition should be dismissed.


Dismissal
