FINAL ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR  
RELIEF FROM AN UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICE

Petitioner filed an amended Charge of Discrimination on a number of bases, and a Petition for Relief, but limited her claim at the hearing to handicap discrimination.

A hearing by an Administrative Law Judge was held who recommended that the Charge of Discrimination be dismissed because no discrimination was proven.

No exceptions by Petitioner can be found in the file.

The Judge's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are accepted because there is competent substantial evidence to support the Judge's findings of fact and there is no recognizable error of law as applied to the facts of the case.

**Dismissal**

The Petition for Relief is hereby dismissed.

The parties have the right to seek judicial review of this Order. The Commission and the appropriate District Court of Appeal must receive a notice of appeal within 30 days of the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Commission. Explanation of the right to appeal is found in Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and in the Florida Rules of Appellate procedure, Rule 9.110.
