FINAL ORDER DISMISSING REQUEST FOR  
RELIEF FROM AN UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICE

Petitioner filed a complaint of discrimination claiming she was discriminated against because of her gender. A hearing was held, and a transcript was made. No exceptions were found in the file. The Judge found for the Respondent on the merits because there was no evidence of discrimination, and recommended dismissal of the Petition.

The Judge's dismissal on the merits was correct since it was supported by competent substantial evidence in the record, and the Petition should be dismissed.

**Dismissal**

The Petition for Relief is hereby **Dismissed**. The parties have the right to seek judicial review of this Order. The Commission and the appropriate District Court of Appeal must receive a notice of appeal within 30 days of the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Commission. Explanation of the right to appeal is found in Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and in the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure 9.110.
